IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the “Last Known Address of the Decedent” will have to be identified and included as a “filing requirement” for the legal documents described below that are filed with the County Clerk’s Office for the El Paso Statutory Probate Courts No. 1 and No. 2.


1. Application Probate Will with Letters Testamentary;
2. Application for Probate of Foreign Will;
3. Application Probate Will as Muniment of Title;
4. Application for Independent Administration/Dependent Administration/Administration/Temporary Administration;
5. Small Estate Affidavits;
6. Applications to Determine Heirship; and
7. Application for Sale of Real Property of a Minor by a Parent without a Guardianship

WHEREBY this Administrative Order will become effective 4-26-11  2011, and all legal instruments described above that fail to identify the “Last Known Address of the Decedent” will be rejected for filing at the County Clerk’s Office for the benefit of the El Paso Statutory Probate Courts No. 1 and No. 2.
